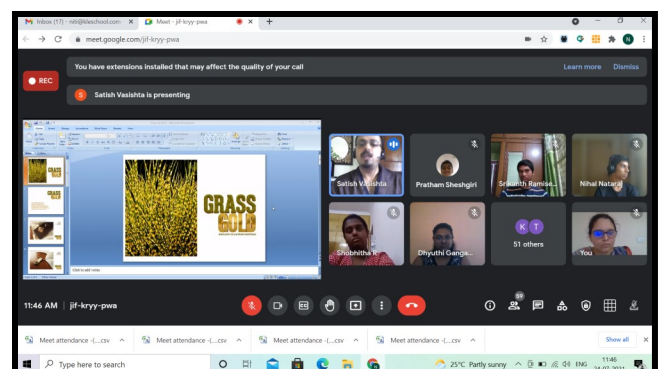
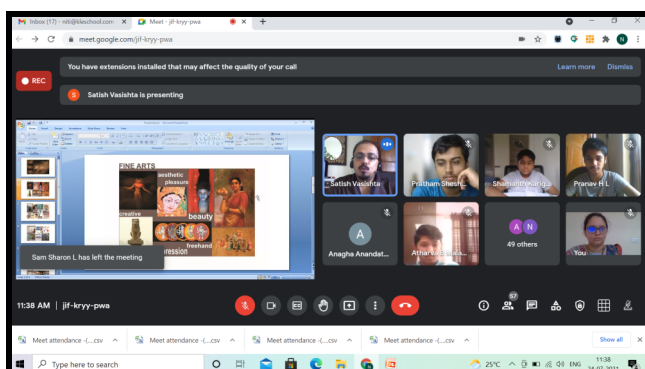
Over 116 students took part in the webinar, which discussed the various issues pertaining to careers in Jewellery designing, fashion and fine arts.

He also gave a brief introduction about his research in this field.

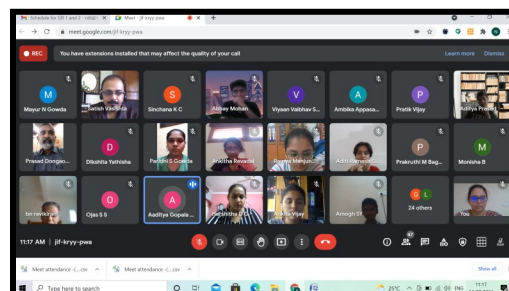
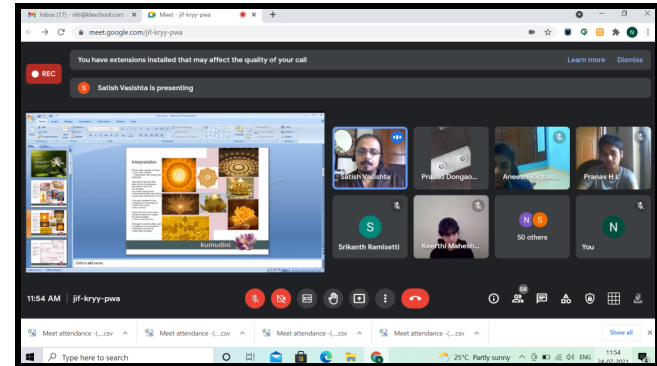
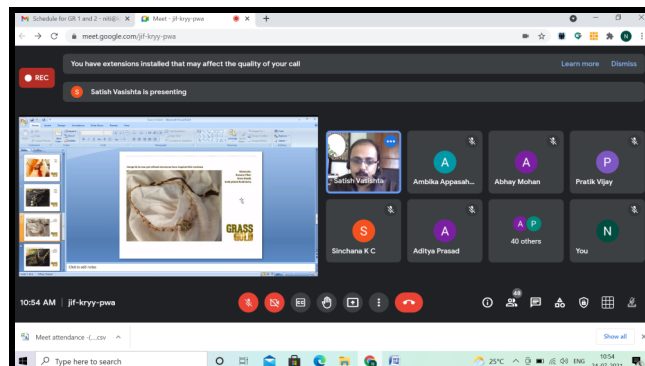
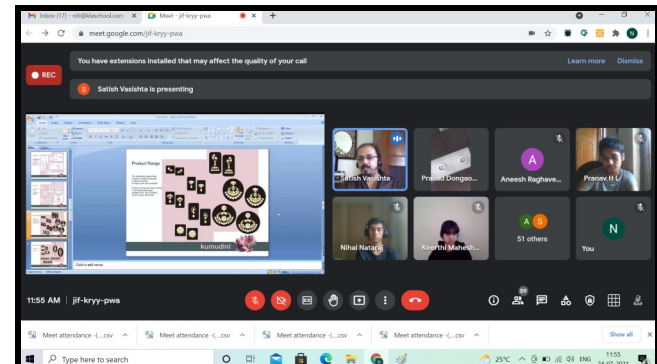
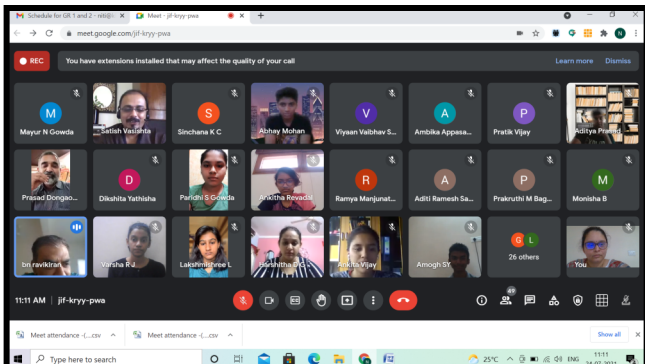
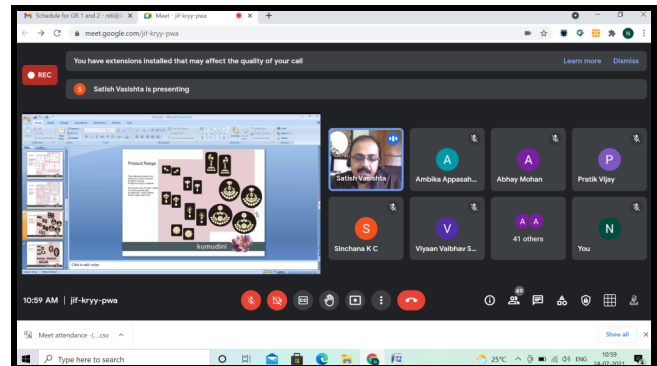
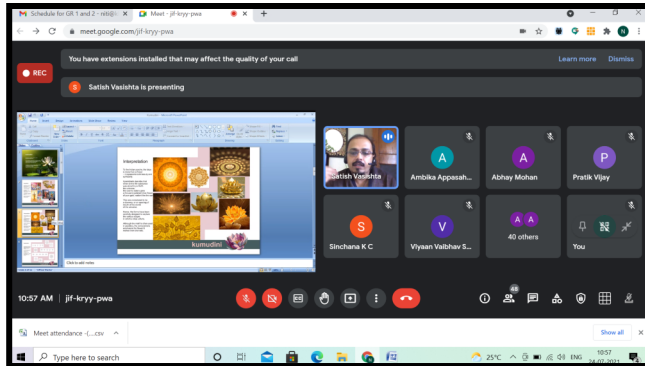
The aim of the session was to promote the idea that there is a wide range of career options nowadays and students should think about these varied options in consultation with their parents.

At last, Aaditya Acharya and Unnati M of Grade 10 rendered the vote of thanks.



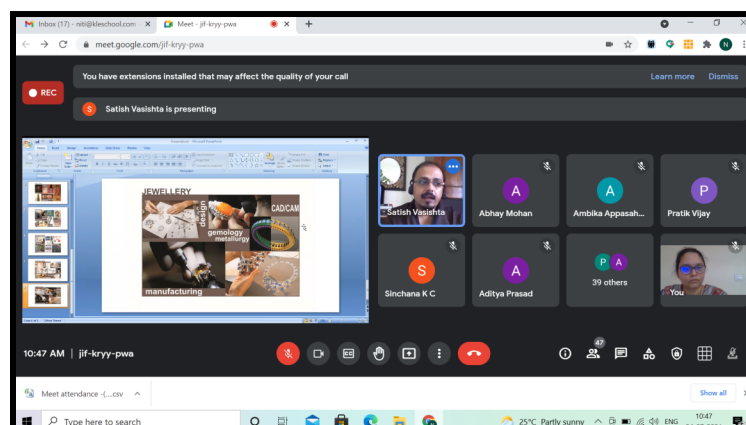
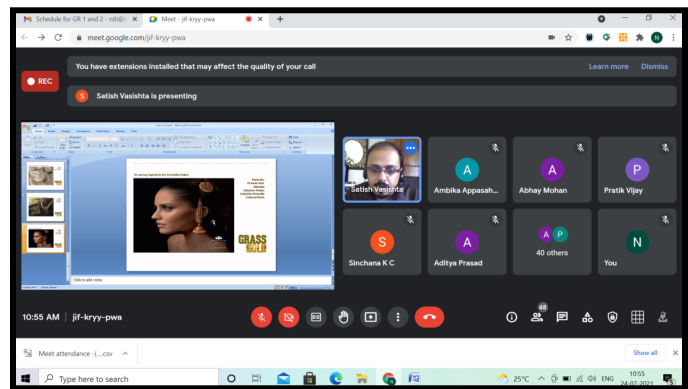
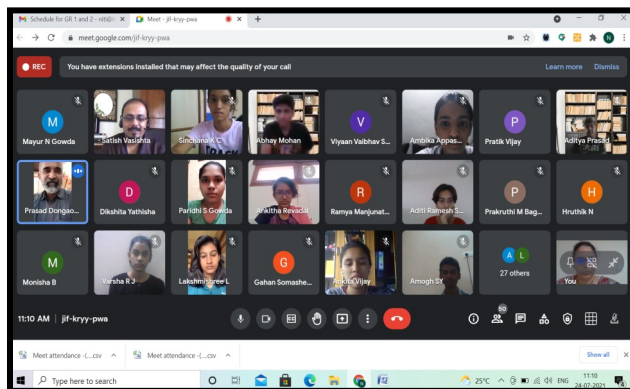
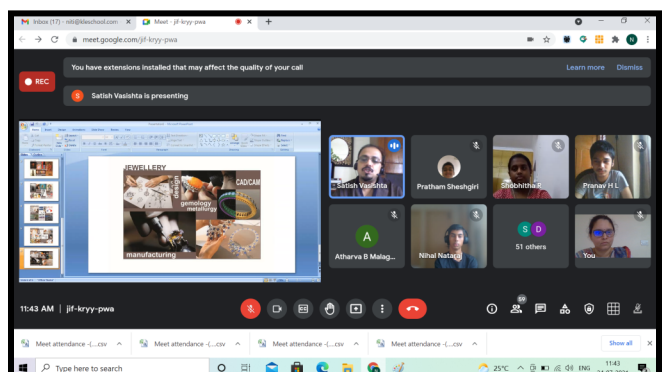
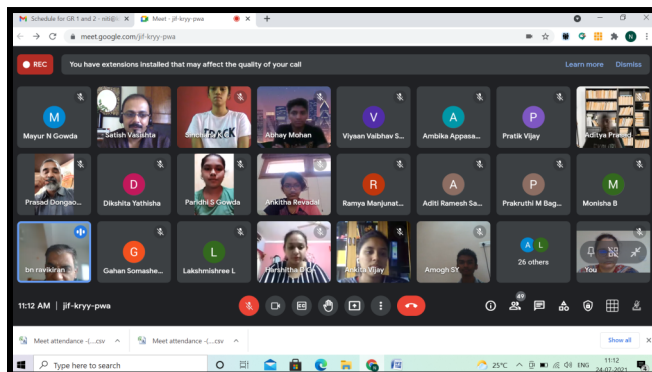
