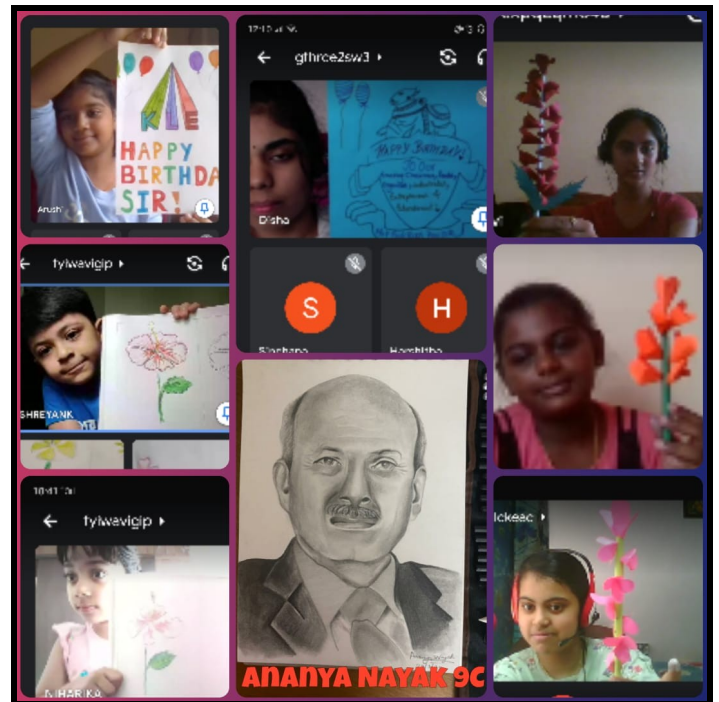
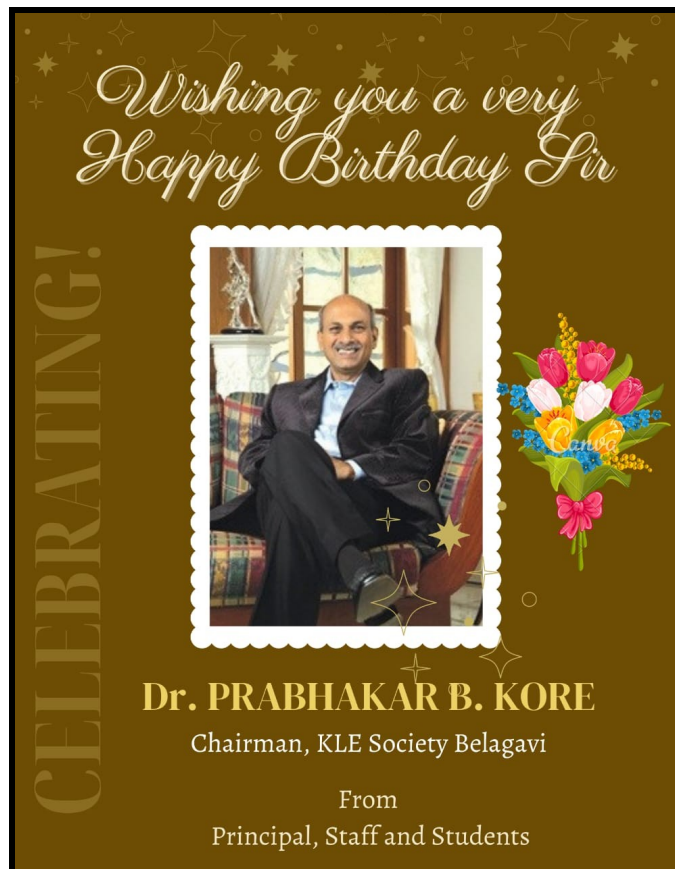

A programme was organized on a small scale due to the ongoing pandemic, but the enthusiasm was amplified as always, among the teaching staff.

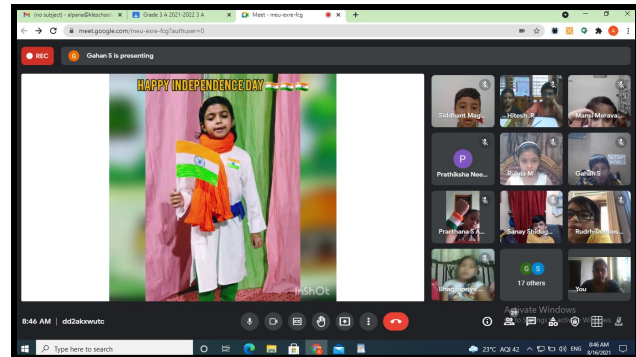
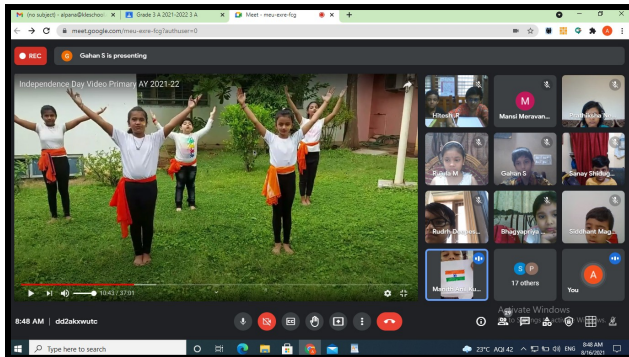
Even though the Covid-19 pandemic has been a dampener for most events, the school didn't let it bring down its patriotic spirit.
