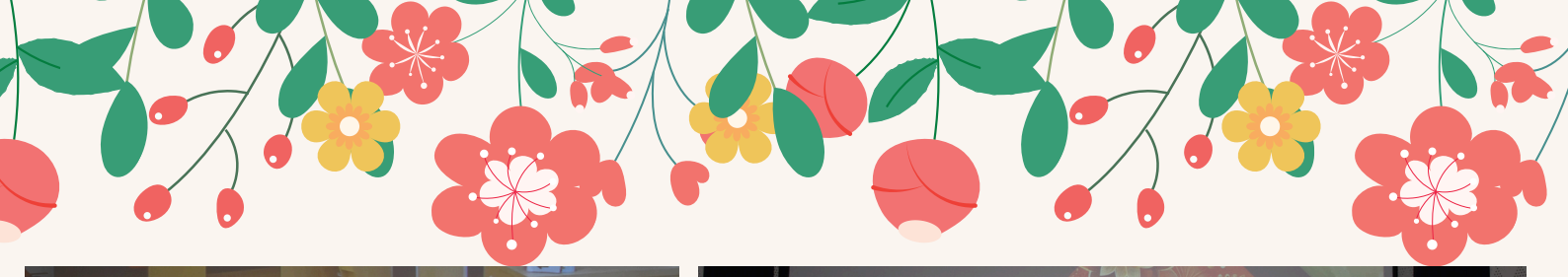















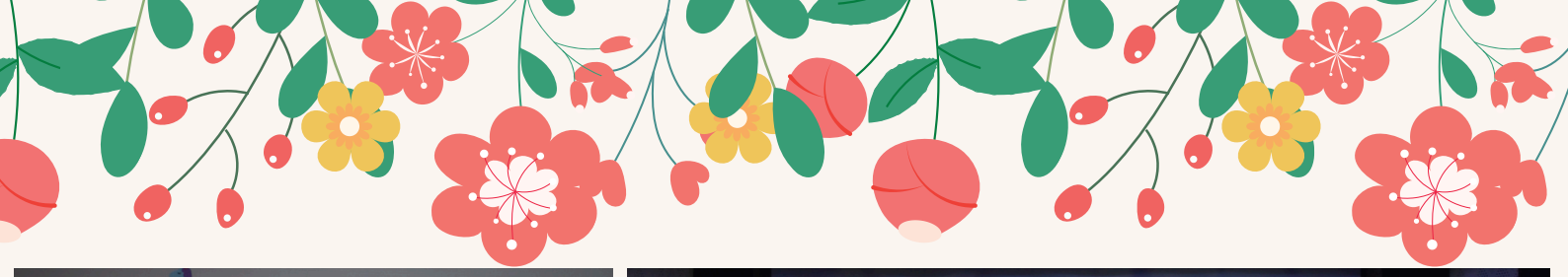
CHILDREN'S DAY CELEBRATION

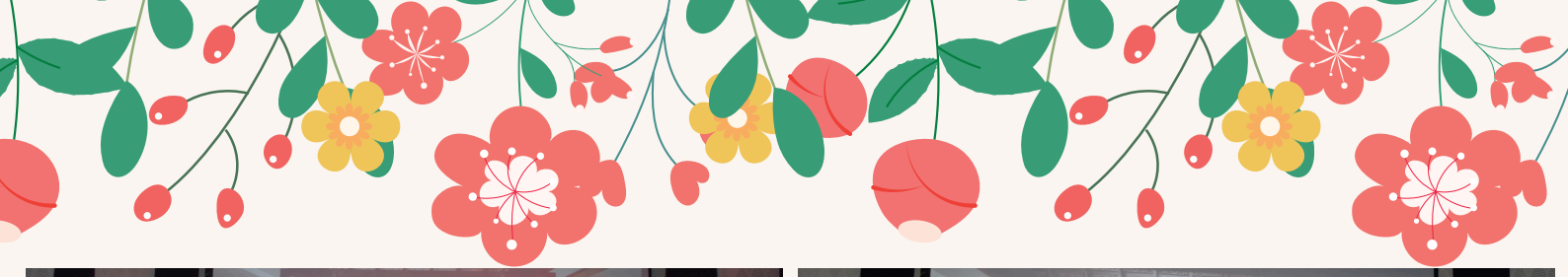
